

John 17: 1 - 5

(Jesus just finished talking about the fact that He will be killed and then will be resurrected.)

Joh 17:1 After Jesus said this, he looked toward heaven and prayed: "Father, the time has come. Glorify your Son, that your Son may glorify you. Joh 17:2 For you granted him authority over all people that he might give eternal life to all those you have given him. Joh 17:3 Now this is eternal life: that they may know you, the only true God, and Jesus Christ, whom you have sent. Joh 17:4 I have brought you glory on earth by completing the work you gave me to do. Joh 17:5 And now, Father, glorify me in your presence with the glory I had with you before the world began.

15. What does verse 5 teach about the change Jesus experienced when He came into the world?

Philippians 2: 5 - 11

Php 2:5 Your attitude should be the same as that of Christ Jesus: Php 2:6 Who, being in very nature God, did not consider equality with God something to be grasped, Php 2:7 but made himself nothing, taking the very nature of a servant, being made in human likeness. Php 2:8 And being found in appearance as a man, he humbled himself and became obedient to death-- even death on a cross! Php 2:9 Therefore God exalted him to the highest place and gave him the name that is above every name, Php 2:10 that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, Php 2:11 and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.
